

May 10, 2022 – Village Board Meeting Minutes 7:00 pm – Casco Village

Dennis made a motion to approve the agenda Chad 2nd (7:01 pm); Board members present: Dennis Cravillion, Chad Cochart, Tim Kinnard, Kelly Pinchart – President, Tammy Skarban-Clerk Absent: Troy Alsteen

- **Board of Review was called to order: 7:01 pm**
 - Dennis Cravillion was elected as Chairperson
 - Chad Cochart was Co-Chairperson
 - No one present, switched back to regular meeting (7:03 pm)
 - Resumed BOR at 8:55 to review Assessments –
 - Bill told us our re-val has already dropped to 96% because of the housing market but our assessment for the Village is at \$35,839,100 which is an increase of 1.881 million
 - BOR adjourned at 9:01

Updates from Bruce

- Asked Thad about the Bipartisan grant, we must spend \$250,000 to even apply so we are better off waiting for the LRIP which is every other year
- Jesse Schley (County) can do crack filling from Old Orchard south to West Ave - \$6500, to put a layer on Burke Ave will cost approx. \$9000; we can also check with Scott Construction for Dbl Chip
- Front tire on field tractor was replaced by Seiler Tire
- New mower came in last week, looking for a thatcher attachment (approx. \$900)
- Village Rummage sale had old lawn mower out and Bruce took sealed bids, 1 bid was accepted
- Problem with a pump at the Sewer plant – full of rust (7:29)

Land and Water Update:

- **No** results from the study are back yet
- Grant did get approved for 300 tests in July and 300 tests in November
- As of Friday, the Daycare is in “DOJ” status
- Free water tests will be available in July and November. All residents are encouraged to contact the Land and Water office to be added to the list. 920-845-9740 we would like 100 people
- Lisa asked if a lay person could be on this board, they said it goes to the County Board for more feedback
- “Frost Spreading” is happening. This is putting fertilizer on a field when the field is dead (8:12 pm)
- Minutes were approved as presented, Tim made the motion to accept, with Chad 2nd the motion – all approved (7:31 pm)
- Bills were presented, Chad made a motion to approve all except Luxemburg Rescue (will discuss next month), Dennis 2nd the motion, all approved (7:45 pm)

New Business

- **Lot 1 (Block 2)** someone wanted to purchase to put up a storage shed. It was decided that lot should be for a duplex or home instead since it is in the beginning of the subdivision.
- Mark LeMense is interested in purchasing 2 lots, 113 & 115 Braeburn
- Lions are putting a steel roof on the A’s stand, looking to see if the bathroom needs to be replaced also. They want to see if they could do this and then not make a donation to the Village for a few years. (8:20)
- Stop sign on 3rd Street needs to be replaced. A town resident wants it removed since it is faded, and the trees need to be trimmed (8:35 pm)
- Land south of Village 150’ from lot line south, 60’ right of way – LC FFA wants to plant beans, they can continue but the Village can build or move land at any time. (8:50 pm)
- Sewer plant has lost (killed) a lot of bugs. Something went through the system
- Jay Vandervest & Paul Vincent will be cutting trees on 2nd Street

Old Business
