- Setting up citations for noncompliance
- Was approved by the court
- We will need to update our citation ordinance and appoint someone to issue them. As of now it will be Tammy.
- Court dates will be wrapped up by mid-summer
- Fines will be issued first before a jury trial. We must be consistent with procedures
- If it costs 50% of the value to fix a home, it can be raised.
- A violation is a violation.
- All citations will be sent certified mail.
- Zoning ordinances can be done on our own, Tyler can give us guidance. 6:45

#### Bruce/Rob

- WPS update: there are no hours used at the park, this is a meter charge only.
- Stop sign will be put up on 1st Street and Old Orchard and streets in the subdivision
- We are eligible for the LRIP this year; Burke Ave and Hyland Ave (south)
- Ron McClure and crew removed trees at the sewer plant. Took 88 hours.
- Wastewater permit expires this fall; renewal has been sent in.
- Both sand filters weren't working; VPC was called in to fix them.
- Gasket deteriorated causing an air leak.
- Water leak in basement is coming from outside; Jay will take a look at it.
- Regional grant was applied for by the fire department; \$158,000
  - o 12 fire calls in 2023; 10 were mutual aid
  - o Almost \$1000 under budget
  - o Tires for fire truck will be ordered from Cochart's.
- Cameras will be installed at the sewer plant. Only Village residents are allowed to bring yard waste –
  NO full trees can be dropped off. 7:16

- The ADA ramps will be painted this summer
- Troy is looking into purchasing a small woodchipper (6" or less), once again, no full trees!
- Land offer purchase was submitted to LC School district for \$125(k) 7:54
- Letters will be going out to people to clean their yards/pick up last years leaves.

- Sewer bill pricing will be looked at; we want to make sure everyone is being billed correctly. All businesses and all residents that have an extra building with a bathroom will be charged accordingly. If residents have another building on their property with a bathroom, they should be charged for an extra sewer charge. We will be looking into how to charge everyone, so it is fair to all. Bills are due the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month following the end of the quarter (April, July, October, January). Bills not paid in full by October 28<sup>th</sup> will automatically be added to your property tax bill, with a penalty charge.
- Any business on a residential lot will have to be rezoned.
- All businesses are subject to fire inspection, for your safety and the safety of others. 8:07
