- LRIP will start on Hyland the week of September 16.

Tim told her that she needs to contact the County with her findings so if there is something that needs to be done, they can take care of it.
- Preliminary budget numbers were given out. We will schedule a "Budget meeting" at our next meeting (we don't have all the information yet from the State/County or other components.

## **Old Business**

- Chicken Ordinance was changed to "NO CHICKENS ALLOWED"
- Parking Ordinance was changed to allow overnight parking except from Nov 1 April 1
- Christmas in Casco is scheduled for Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup>

- Trick or Treat in Casco Village will be Sunday, October 27<sup>th</sup> from Noon 2 pm
- Any business on a residential lot will have to be rezoned.
- Fire rating is now 6 for homeowners' insurance effective 8/1/24. Great job Bruce and firemen!
- Citation ordinance went into effect May 22<sup>nd</sup>, all residents were mailed a copy with sewer bill.
- LRIP is for overlay for Burke/Hyland. The cost is \$50,000, we will receive \$14,383.51 when we spend \$35,616.49
- We are going to have to have a full Village wide revaluation, according to the state since we are below the 80% ratio. Our assessor is holding off until 2026.
