# **Budget**

- Taxes will be going out this week. There was a \$1 increase per \$1000; the Village portion actually decreased. Do NOT pay your taxes or dog license with your Sewer bills
- There are a lot of people who are not paying their sewer bills, and they are being rolled to taxes for payment. The county has them in the first payment, but we do not receive the money from the county until the August settlement. Do we need to increase the late fees to encourage people to pay their bills on time? Bills are due on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month preceding the quarter end. If they are not paid by the 10th of the month, a 10% penalty will be added (that is our current rate).
- Do Not pay your sewer bill with your taxes, only taxes and dog licenses can be combined.

• We will be looking at purchasing a CD for the sewer plant to cover costs of replacement (January mtg), Tammy will contact the Bank of Luxemburg for information.
