### **Village Audit – Leah**

- We have unspent debt yet
- Audit went well, everything in order; went faster than last year. 6:58 pm

### **Sheriff Matt Joski**

- The county is dealing with a lot of issues concerning behavioral problems
- Village concerns now are for noise and disorderly conduct with vehicles.
- Will have extra patrol during problem times and be more consistent with coverage
- Working on a “Deflection” grant; it is a DOJ outreach program for undertaking different norms
- Question was asked about changing the speed limit on Main St., but there are certain criteria’s that have to be met.
- If you have questions, just call the non-emergency number anytime and ask
- Jail project isn’t dead, just needed to pump the brakes since we aren’t getting enough applicant’s to fill the positions needed for proper staff.

### **Building Inspector – Brett Guilette**

- Zoning codes need to be rewritten, they contradict themselves
- We need to look at updating the zoning and hiring a zoning administrator
- The Village needs to issue “zoning” permits, not building permits (land use). If you are building a structure or making a structural change, then you will need a “building permit” since it needs to be inspected. If you are adding a fence, a sign, a shed under 150 sq feet, or a pool deck not attached to the house, then that would be a “zoning permit” and they are on the Village website, [www.villageofcascowwi.gov](http://www.villageofcascowwi.gov) called “Land Use Permit”. These permits can be emailed to [clerk@villageofcascowwi.gov](mailto:clerk@villageofcascowwi.gov) or dropped off at 311 Church Ave. along with a check made out to the Village for \$30 and Tammy will get you the permit.
