

October 27, 2025 – Casco Village Ordinance Meeting / Budget Minutes 6pm

Tim. made a motion to approve the agenda Troy 2nd 6 pm; Board members present: Dan Andres, Troy Alsteen, Dan Laak, Chad Cochart – President, Tammy Skarban-Clerk

Chad read the ordinance to residents. The following questions were asked by various people and answered by the board (21 Village residents attended the meeting)

- Why only 2 vehicles per driver – that isn't what the proposed ordinance states
- Who is going to enforce – great question; this is something that needs to be discussed but a resident volunteered to be the enforcer
- What counts as a vehicle – anything with a motor
- Can we have a timetable; can this be a seasonal ordinance
- Can we check the Village of Bellevue's seasonal ordinance
- Can we use our entire yard – must have 60% green space
- Where are agendas posted – same place as the minutes; Bank of Luxemburg, Post Office, Village Hall, Casco One Stop
- Can agendas get posted on our website for meetings – Tammy will look into this (then the agenda/minutes only need to be posted at the Post Office)
- How much are the fines going to be and how often will they be assessed? Is it going to be cheaper just to pay the fine? – this is something that will be discussed with our attorney
- What is the timeframe going to be to get people to be compliant – we will work out a schedule; this won't happen overnight; everyone will have ample time.

Tammy will contact the Bellevue Village Clerk to get their ordinance. We will have further discussions before the ordinance becomes official. 7:05 pm
