

## Chapter 1

### CODE ADOPTION\*

1.01 Adoption. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.035 of the Wisconsin Statutes, there is hereby adopted the "Casco Municipal Code".

1.02 Title--Citation--Reference. This code shall be known as the "Casco Municipal Code" and it shall be sufficient to refer to said code as the "Casco Municipal Code" in any prosecution for the violation of any provision thereof or in any proceeding at law or equity. It shall be sufficient to designate any ordinance adding to, amending, correcting or repealing all or any part or portion thereof as an addition to, amendment to, correction or repeal of the "Casco Municipal Code". Further reference may be had to the titles, chapters, sections, and subsections of the "Casco Municipal Code" and such references shall apply to that numbered titles, chapter, section or subsection as it appears in the code. 1.03 Codification authority. This code consists of all the regulatory and penal ordinances and certain of the administration ordinances of the Village of Casco, Wisconsin, codified pursuant to the provisions of Section 66.035 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

1.04 Ordinances passed prior to adoption of the code. The last ordinance included in this code was the ordinance passed on July 19, 1983, relating to the collection of garbage and this ordinance was the last passed by the Village Board prior to the adoption of this code.

1.05 Reference applies to all amendments. Whenever a reference is made to this code as the "Casco Municipal Code" or to any portion thereof, or to any ordinance of the Village of

Casco, Wisconsin, the reference shall apply to all amendments, corrections and additions heretofore, now or hereafter made.

1.06. Title, chapter, and section headings. Title, chapter and section headings contained herein shall not be deemed to govern, limit, modify or in any manner affect the scope, meaning or intent of the provisions of any title, chapter or section hereof.

1.07. Reference to specific ordinances. The provisions of this code shall not in any manner affect matters of record which refer to, or are otherwise connected with ordinances which are therein specifically designated by number or otherwise and which are included within the code, but such reference shall be construed to apply to the corresponding provisions contained within this code.

1.08. Effect of code on past actions and obligations. Neither the adoption of this code nor the repeal of amendments hereby of any ordinance or part or portion of any ordinance of the village shall in any manner affect the prosecution for violations of ordinances, which violations were committed prior to the effective date hereof, nor be construed as a waiver of any license, fee, or penalty at said effective date due and unpaid under such ordinances, nor be construed as affecting any of the provisions of such ordinances relating to the collection of any such license, fee, or penalty, or the penal provisions applicable to any cash deposit in lieu thereof required to be posted, filed or deposited pursuant to any ordinance and all rights and obligations thereunder appertaining shall continue in full force and effect.

1.09. Effective date. This code shall become effective on 1985, following passage and publication of the ordinance adopting this code as the "Casco Municipal Code".

1.10. Constitutionality-Separability of Code Provisions. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this code is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this code. The village board hereby declares that it would have passed this code, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases had been declared invalid or unconstitutional, then the original ordinance or ordinances shall be in full force and effect.
